Ohio Aid Programs for 2012-2013

Ohio College Opportunity Grant (OCOG) - is for institutions that are public (main campus only), private, for profit, and non profits. The amounts (full time enrollment) vary based on the type of institution.

\$856	Public Main Campus
\$2,280	Private and nonprofit institutions
\$480	For profit institutions

War Orphans Scholarship- is for dependents of deceased or disabled (60% or more) veterans. The state will fund 93% of the student's tuition to a public institution or \$5,575 to a private institution.

Ohio National Guard Scholarship- For National Guard soldiers and must be approved by the Ohio Adjutant General. Soldiers are given free tuition and fees at public institutions and \$8,696 at private institutions.

Safety Officers Memorial- For dependents and spouses of safety officers killed in the line of duty. 100% of public institution tuition and fees are covered, with \$9,056 covered at private institutions.

Nurse Education Assistance Loan Program (NEALP) - Is for students in R.N. programs or programs to become a nurse instructor. The loan can be forgiven after 4 or 5 years of service in Ohio. The amounts vary between \$1,500 and \$5,000
